Introduction

At Castle View Primary school, we believe that children should attend school smartly dressed and in the correct uniform. We believe this helps your child to have an identity with the whole school community and feel part of a very special place. We regard this as a very important factor in giving them a sense of belonging. Our school uniform is designed to be simple, practical and economical. Most items can be easily obtained from any popular store. However, sweatshirts, polo shirts and P.E. kits can be ordered online.

Uniform is a requirement of attending Castle View Primary School.

The uniform comprises:

Navy sweatshirt with the school logo
White polo shirt
Grey or black trousers/skirt/pinafore dress

In Summer, children may wear:
Grey or black short trousers
Blue and white checked dresses.

Footwear:

Sensible black shoes, which no open toes, high or wedged heels or trainers.
In Summer sensible, ankle strapped, sandals in black, brown or white. All of which must be suitable for all school activities, except for P.E.

Any child not wearing appropriate footwear their parent/carers will be contacted and asked to bring in alternatives.

P.E. Clothing:

Shorts - plain black
T-shirt – white with the school logo
Plimsolls for indoor gym work
Trainers for outdoor use
Track suits are an optional extra for the colder months.

All items of clothing must be clearly marked with the pupil's name.

Jewellery must not be worn for reasons of safety. If your child has pierced ears only the smallest of studs should be worn to school, but these must be removed for P.E.

Hair all hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back.

Nursery

Uniform is not compulsory for Nursery pupils, please see the Nursery brochure for expectations of what to wear and bring to Nursery.
