## How to open my tasks

- Log into Google Classroom
- Open up your remote learning classroom
- Select Classwork

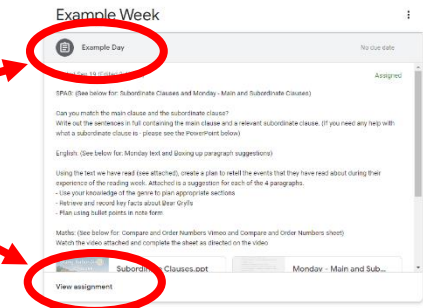


- Find the correct week → Example Week



- Select the correct day

- Click view assignment at the bottom


