We are learning.....

English

We will read a playscript "The Battle of Edlington" and write our own, using the features of this style of writing.

We will also read the traditional story "The Grey Dog" and write our own continuation of it using adjectives and adverbs to add description.

Communication and Language

Each child will have a perfect partner who they will talk to during discussions, problem solving and reasoning activities, to share their ideas with before they feed back to the class.

PSED (Personal, Social and emotional Development)

We will consider the diversity of Britain in our PHSE sessions. This will include looking at discrimination and the identity of others. We constantly promote democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs and for those without faith.

Maths

We will complete our work on Multiplication and Division.

Year 3 will work on understanding and applying times tables facts and be able to count in 4s, 8s, 50s and 100s. We will use scaling to solve larger number problems based on our times table knowledge.

Year 4 will build on their times table facts to multiply and divide by 10 and 100 and count in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 5 and 1000. They will use this knowledge to solve increasingly more complex problems.

Our Learning is around the topic... Worker or Warrior?

We will experience life as it was during the Anglo-Saxon time period.

Music

We will be looking at How does Music make the World a Better Place? Our music lessons will cover Listening, Singing, Playing Composing and Performing.

History

Our historical enquiry will focus of the Anglo-Saxons, who they were and how they lived.

Geography

We will build on our knowledge of compass points to use the 8 points of a compass and grid references to locate places significant in the Anglo-Saxon period and in our local area.

Computing

We will use coding programmes on Purple Mash to create commands to be able to draw shapes, patterns and letters.

French

This term, we will learn to listen to and repeat words relating to the body, the face and aches and pains.

RE

We will be looking at Anglo Saxon Pagan beliefs v Christian beliefs of the time.

Physical Development
