## We are learning.....

### English

We will be writing our own narrative, based on the book *Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs*, incorporating adjectives, adverbs, similes and metaphors.

We will also be planning an interview with Joe Wicks, focussing on the importance of a healthy lifestyle through diet and exercise.

### PSED (Personal, Social and emotional Development)

We will focus on recognising our individuality and personal qualities to give us a feeling of self-worth.

We will also consider how those qualities can be suited for future careers and the different routes to take towards a chosen career.

We constantly promote democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs and for those without faith.

### Maths

In Year 3, we will complete our work on Fractions and then work on telling the time in a variety of ways.

In Year 4, we will complete our work on Decimals and seeing links between decimals and fractions. We will also link our decimal work to money and adding and subtracting amounts.

### Music

We will be looking at how music helps us connect with our planet. Our music lessons will cover Listening, Singing, Playing Composing and Performing.

### Science

### Design & Technology

### French
