## An Ocean Made of Plastic

### Class: Endeavour

## We are learning:

### Literacy (Reading and Writing)

**Spelling and grammar:** The children will be learning spelling, punctuation and grammar rules to apply to their reading and writing.

**Newspaper reports:** We will be reading and writing reports based around the pollution of Earth's waters.

**Persuasion:** We will research the effects that plastic has on our world and what we can do to help the planet. We will try to persuade others to support our efforts in reducing plastic waste in our school community.

### History, Geography and Science

Science this term will focus on living things and their habitats. We will be focusing on how we can classify animals and plants differently based upon their characteristics.

This unit's Geography will be a fieldwork study. We will use our map skills to explore and map areas of our school community before following made maps with our compasses.

### Computing and RE

In Computing we will be collecting a range of data before inputting it into spreadsheets.

Our key question in RE this term is "What matters most to Christians and Humanists?"

Our learning is all about An Ocean Made of Plastic.

### Expressive Arts and Design (Art, D&T and Music)

The children will be focusing their skills on sewing and stitching this term. They will be creating a project using cross stitch techniques.

In music we will be answering the question How Does Music teach us about our community?

### Mathematics

Year 5 - **Multiplication and Division** - We will be learning what factors and multiples are as well as how to multiply and divide by 10, 100 & 1000. **Before using a range of methods to multiply and divide numbers up to 4 digits.**

Year 6 - We will begin the term by exploring decimals before moving our learning onto fractions, decimals and percentages. We will conclude the term with perimeter, area and volume.

### PSED (Personal, Social and emotional Development)

We constantly promote democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs and for those without faith. We will be focusing on digital well-being this term.

### Physical Development (PE)

Through the sport of hockey this children will be improving their attacking and defending skills.
