Where in the world is
Barnaby Bear?

Class: Little Stars

Teachers: Miss Panter and Mrs Taylor

We are learning:

Literacy (*Reading and Writing*)

Phonics – the children will practise their phonemes and use them in their reading and writing.

Labels: We will be labelling the parts of Barnaby Bear and the items in his suitcase. This links to our science work of labelling parts of the human body.

Lists: We will be writing lists to help Barnaby Bear pack his suitcase and write a list to help him plan his party.

Captions: We will write captions to match Barnaby Bear's holiday photos.

Expressive Arts and Design

ART

We will be sketching and painting portraits of ourselves.

D & T

We will look at the nets of boxes, and remake disassembled boxes to produce new luggage bags for Barnaby.

Music

Our topic in music this term is "How can we make friends when we sing together?" We will be learning how music can bring people together through a wide range of musical styles, and how to find the beat in a piece of music.

PSHE (Personal, Social, health and economic)

Our PSHE topic this term is called 'Team' and is inspired by the idea that if a team works well together, it can have a positive impact on all of its members and what they can achieve.

We will also be establishing our class rules, and settling into our rules, routines and expectations of being a Year 1. We will talk about what kinds of things we must do to earn Castle Coins.

Our Learning is around the topic...Where is Barnaby Bear?

**Our topic will end with:
Designing our own suitcases for Barnaby Bear.**

Physical Development (PE)

We will be having daily mini yoga sessions after registration to relax us and learn about wellbeing. In PE, we will practise moving with more control and balance and in different ways, stopping and starting, and changing directions. In Enrichment we will be exploring the outdoors through our "Forest School" sessions.

Mathematics

We will be practising our place value with numbers to 10, then 20, moving on to addition and subtraction.

We will be solving addition and subtraction problems using the '+', '-' and '=' signs.

Understanding of the World

Geography

Through tracking Barnaby Bear's travels through his postcards, we will be learning about the 4 countries in the UK (England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales) and their four capital cities (London, Belfast, Edinburgh and Cardiff) and some of the features of these places.

Computing

We will type luggage labels out on the computers in the ICT suite practising to write our full names on the keyboard.

Science

We will be learning to name and label the different parts of the human body.

RE

In RE our topic "Who is a Christian and what do they believe?" we will discuss Christian beliefs about God and Jesus through words, drama and pictures.
