We are learning:

Literacy (Reading and Writing)

Spelling and grammar: The children will be learning spelling, punctuation and grammar rules to apply to their reading and writing.

Myths and legends: We will explore the story of Theseus and the Minotaur to produce a diary

Poetry: We will be creating Greek Haiku poems from the myth and legend stories that we experience throughout the topic.

PSED (Personal, Social and emotional Development)

Through our topic, the children will be exploring saving and expenses.

We constantly promote democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs and for those without faith.

Physical Development (PE)

Through tennis and rounders the children will be developing their hand-eye co-ordination as well as their competitive strategy.

Communication and

Language (Speaking and Listening)

Each child will have a perfect partner who they will talk to during discussions, problem solving and reasoning activities, to share their ideas with before they feed back to the class.

Our learning is focused on how Ancient Greece has influenced our lives today.

History

We will be exploring how Ancient Greece has influenced the Western world today.

Science

We will be looking at Electricity in Science. Through the unit we'll be investigating brightness and the affects of a buzzer on a circuit. We'll also be using symbols to create simple circuit diagrams.

Mathematics

Year 5: We will be learning about fractions during this term. This will including adding, subtract, multiplying and dividing fractions.

They will then be focusing on decimal and percentages before completing their perimeter and area unit.

Year 6:

Perimeter, Area and Volume - Children will build on their knowledge of area and perimeter to explore the area of a triangles and parallelograms.

The children will begin their maths revision in preparation for their SATs once the previous unit is taught.

Art and Design

The children will be creating models of chairs and forming these from 2D sketches to 3D pieces.

Music

Through the term the children will be discussing the questions 'How does music shape our way in life?'

French

The children will be learning the vocabulary for indoor and outdoor sports.
