



**Intent – we aim to...**

Teach Spanish to all KS2 children to support them on their path to Secondary Education.	Develop language skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing.	Provide our KS2 children with a high quality education in Modern Foreign Languages (MFL), which develops their love of learning other languages and cultures.	Teach children to appreciate the diversity of cultures and languages in a multi-lingual society and to be able to communicate effectively with others.	Celebrate the Spanish language through a language day experience
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**Implementation – How do we achieve our aim?**

<b>Planning</b> – Spanish is planned and delivered by a language specialist using the ‘Lingutots’ scheme. Year 3,4,5 and 6 (KS2) cover 2 topics per term which covers: All About Me, Songs and Games, Celebrations, Portraits, The Four Friends and Growing things.	<b>Recording</b> - All lessons are recorded in Spanish books. Speaking and listening is assessed by the Language Specialist. Children are given the opportunity to read words, sentences and extracts as well as opportunities to write.
<b>Assessment</b> – MFL is assessed at the end of each unit using an assessment grid which links directly to the objectives used for planning. The teaching specialist uses their professional judgement based on all of the skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening) for the unit being achieved. This is shared with the subject lead.	<b>Vocabulary</b> – The children learn a wide range of vocabulary throughout KS2. Each unit is broken down into vocabulary, grammar and phonics. The vocabulary, grammar and phonics is built upon so the children can use prior learning to support new topics.
<b>EYFS</b> – N/A	<b>SEND</b> - Children with SEND are able to access the MFL curriculum due to the way language lessons are taught. Lessons include visual resources, lots of repetition, games and singing. Lessons are planned and resourced to enable all children to access their language learning at an appropriate level for them.



**Impact – How do we know if we’ve achieved our aim?**

All KS2 pupils have developed key language learning skills set out by the National Curriculum.	Children have established positive views and attitudes towards learning a language.
