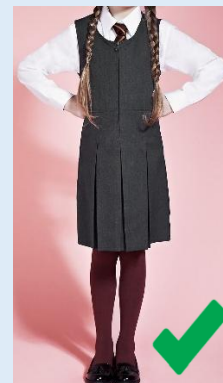

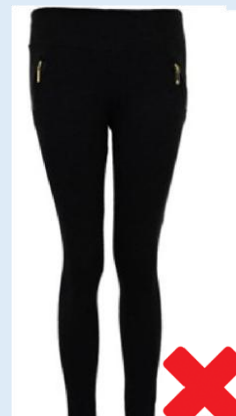
White Polo

Footwear:

Sensible plain black shoes, (no open toes, high or wedged heels, crocs, trainers or coloured logos/stripes)



No crocs



Trainers must be completely black – no coloured logos or white soles.



No heels

Any child not wearing appropriate footwear their parent/carers will be contacted and asked to bring in alternatives.

P.E. Clothing:

Shorts, Trousers or Leggings - plain black (small logos are accepted but not strips or large logos)



T-shirt – Navy with the school logo

Sports Trainers

Children can wear plain navy zip up jumpers for PE, otherwise school jumpers or cardigans should still be worn.



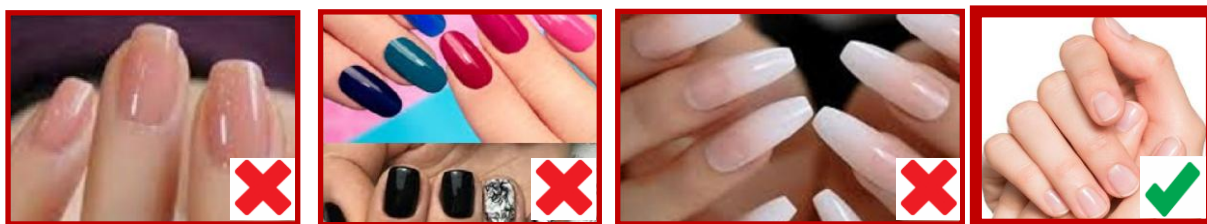
Jewellery

- One pair of stud earrings may be worn – no other piercings are permitted.
- A wrist watch may be worn.

Please be advised that jewellery is personal property and not that of the school. Lost or damaged items will not be refunded. All jewellery must be removed during practical lessons, including PE lessons.

Nails

Long nails and any type of false nails (including clear gels, acrylics, extensions, Shellac etc) are not allowed.



Bags

Pupils must use an appropriately-sized waterproof bag to carry their belongings

School bags featuring inappropriate images, slogans or phrases will not be permitted.

School discourages pupils from bringing valuable bags to school. The school will not be liable for lost or damaged school bags.

Hairstyles and headwear

School reserves the right to make a judgement on whether a pupil's hairstyle, hair colour or headwear is inappropriate for the school environment; however, we will ensure that any such judgements do not discriminate against any pupil by virtue of their protected characteristics. Each individual pupil's scenario will be considered where any judgements on appropriateness are to be made, and parents will always have the freedom to complain via each school's Complaints Procedures Policy.

Pupils with hair past their shoulders wear it tied up for school.

The following hairstyles, hair colours and headwear are not considered appropriate for school:

- Brightly-coloured dyed hair
- Headwear with bold patterns or colours
- Excessive hair accessories

Adverse weather

All pupils will be advised to wear weather-appropriate clothing.

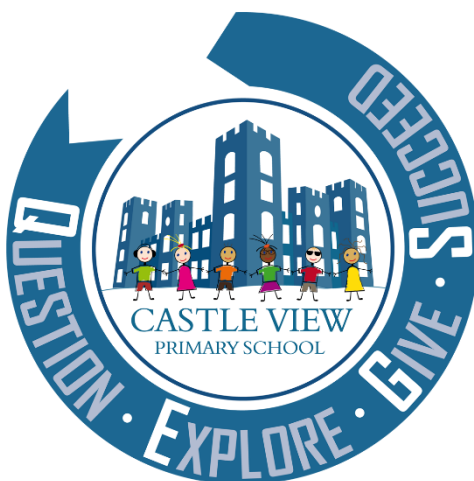
For hot temperatures, this includes wearing:

- Tops that cover the shoulder area.
- Sunhats

Pupils will be advised not to wear any jumpers or cardigans during heatwaves. If outside during break times, pupils not wearing sun-safe clothing will be advised to stay in an area protected from the sun, or spare clothing is provided.

For cold temperatures, this includes wearing:

- Scarfs, gloves, coats and hats when outside.
- Warm jumpers.
- Trousers, or skirts and thick tights.



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
